

Starting June 14th, services will be held at the church at 9:00 and 10:30 am. The 9:00 am service will also be streamed live.

1. If you are experiencing a fever, cough, or any signs of sickness, please stay home. We are encouraging anyone in the at-risk category to stay at home as well.
2. Please follow social distancing guidelines.
3. The building will open at 8:45 for the 9:00 am services. Everyone will enter through the front doors. Every other pew will be closed and families must sit together. Please fill from front to back. If overflow is necessary, we will open the fellowship hall to be entered only through the double doors on the lower level. Please exit through these same doors.
4. When the service is over, everyone will be dismissed by rows and exit out of the front left door. Both sets of stairs will be closed.
5. We will not be serving communion or passing the offering plate. There will be a drop box at each entrance for your tithe or you can continue to mail it in or drop it off at the bank.
6. At this time, there will be no Sunday school classes or children's church and the nursery will not be available. Instead of clipboards, children can pick up a package of crayons and coloring pages on their way in and can take them home.
7. We will be sanitizing highly touched areas between services. As a result, the 9:00 services will end by 9:50 and the doors will remain locked until 10:25. Please wait in your cars until you see the front door is opened.
8. The doors will be propped open. However, if they need to be closed due to weather, please allow the greeter to open and close the doors.
9. In an effort to speed up the sanitizing between services, there will be only one restroom open on both levels.
